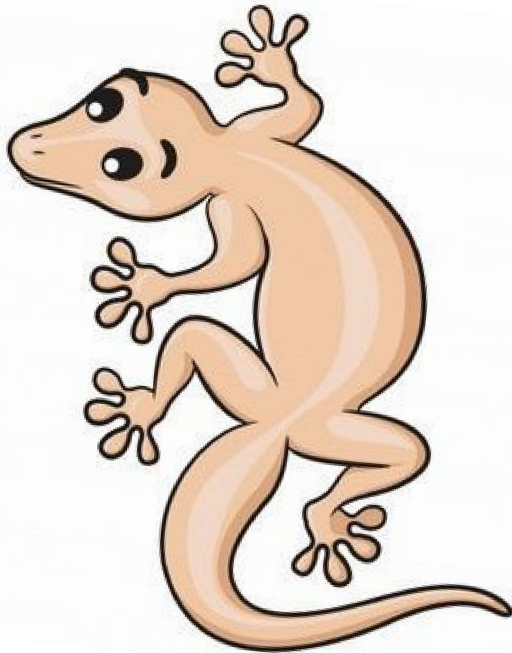

Lizards

- Lizards are part of a group of animals known as reptiles. They are most closely related to snakes.
- The scientific name of the Lizard is Lacertilia. Lizards come in different shapes and sizes, from the chameleons and geckos which are several centimeters in length to the 3-meter long Komodo dragon.
- Lizards are carnivorous and are the 'sit-and-wait' predators.



Facts about Lizards

- While household lizards are not venomous, they do leave hazardous germs behind. This is because lizards like to eat flies and mosquitoes and other blood-sucking and germy vector carriers. When they defecate, you may come in contact with the lizard droppings and potentially contract an illness.

How To Get Rid of Lizards In The Yard

- Reduce the insect population in your yard with a broadcast application of Bifen LP Granules which is labeled to control a wide variety of small insects. This takes away the Lizard's food source.
- Apply a broadcast treatment of Bifen LP Granules over your entire yard at a rate of 2.3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Conduct two perpendicular pass-throughs for even, uniform coverage.
